BLUE GUITAR bumped with an inner foe at the start, tracked from the two path, pressed three deep around the far

turn, bid along with an outer foe entering the lane but yielded. AL TIRAH broke outwardly while last away, trailed along the inside advanced into the far turn before swinging to the seven path entering the lane, and narrowed the gap on the main group. VIVID EXPOSURE showed the way along the inside, got headed by an outer presser with five furlongs to go, stalked that one shortly after but faded around the far turn.
