

BERNIN HOT prompted along the inside before stalking into the turn, offered a rail bid in upper stretch, but was outkicked and yielded late. OLIVIER showed the way in the two path but faded between horses entering midstretch. PATRIARCHAL trailed and made little impact. KISSTHEMOON chased three wide, but was outkicked by an outer rival and gave way between horses in upper stretch.
